Creative Commons Licences are made of elements:



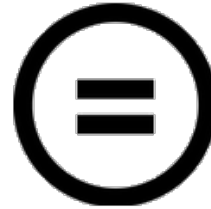
Represents that the work has a Creative Common Licence

attribute the author



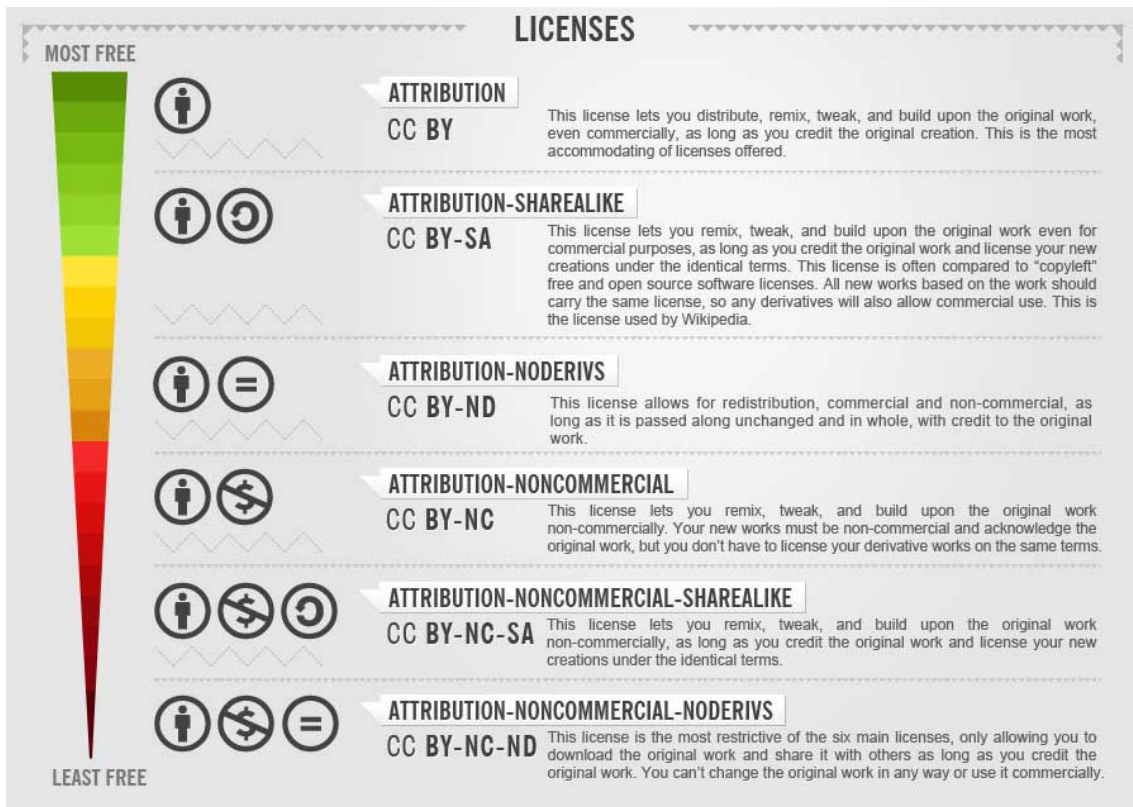
**Non-commercial**  
no commercial purposes



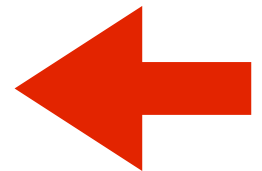
**No Derivative Works**
